## **SELECTING OFFICIAL CHAPTER DELEGATES**

In order to have a successful and productive convention business session, there needs to be **well informed and prepared delegates**. The Wisconsin Association of FFA recommends the following criteria when your chapter is selecting official delegates to represent your chapter. Each chapter is allowed 2 official delegates. Delegate names must be submitted on the State FFA Convention Online Registration.

- 1. Delegates must have received Chapter FFA Degree or State FFA Degree. (Stated in WI FFA Constitution)
- 2. Delegates are well versed in parliamentary procedure.
- 3. Delegates must have attended at least 1 state or national level leadership development conference.
- 4. Delegates have a good, solid knowledge base of the FFA on the chapter and state levels.
- 5. Delegates have a mature attitude about their duties and are willing to take on responsibility.
- 6. Delegates are able to think well on their feet and communicate well with others.
- 7. Delegates have a basic understanding of the qualities of a good state officer and are able to make wise decisions from evaluating another's performance.
